

# Chambers' Diversity Data Report September 2020

#### INTRODUCTION

In accordance with the <u>Bar Standards Board's Handbook on Equality Rules</u>, this report summarises 25 Bedford Row's diversity data as collected in 2020.


85 individuals were given the opportunity to provide diversity data. The survey was conducted between 14 August and 11 September 2020. The completion of the survey was voluntary and conducted in such a way so as to guarantee the anonymity of those who contributed.

80 responses consented to providing the diversity data in the survey and for that data to be both processed and published. This represents approximately 94% of Chambers' workforce which includes both members and staff.

We cannot publish diversity data relating to the diversity characteristics of sexual orientation, religion or belief since consent to this data being processed and published was not received by all of Chambers' workforce.






















